

Dinosaur Roar!

Our theme this half term is 'Dinosaurs'. During this theme we will be learning about dinosaurs. We will be classifying them according to their body parts, talking about the food that they eat and whether they are a herbivore, carnivore.

To support your child's learning, you could try completing a few of the following activities:

- Find out about your favourite dinosaur online or using a non-fiction book. Find out some amazing facts and write them.
- Draw a picture of your favourite dinosaur and label the body parts.
- Create your own non-fiction book about dinosaurs.
- Create your own dinosaur. What would it look like? What would you call it? Draw a picture and describe it.
- Create your own add or take away problem using dinosaurs. E.g. thirteen Pterodactyls were on a tree and 5 flew away. How many are left? Draw a picture to show how you worked it out.
- Make your own fossil or dinosaur egg you could use different materials.
