Nite Owls is a birds of prey demonstration team and they will be holding a talk and giving a flying display session for the children to take part in and observe. Nite Owls have provided us with their risk assessment and they will adhere to our own enhanced procedures during the time they are with us.

Nite Owls are making no charge for their visit to the school but instead the children will be given the wonderful opportunity to have their photograph taken holding the beautiful Barn Owl, Whisper, which will be a lovely souvenir of what we hope to be a great experience for the children.
