The Enchanted Forest:

During this three week topic we will be making our own Magical lands, writing descriptions of magical and mythical creatures as well as making Peg Magical creatures and mud Bog Babies.

Monsters: Key Text - Monstersaurus

During this theme we will be making Monster Potions looking at capacity and writing recipes for our potions. We will also be learning how to manipulate clay to make clay monsters.

Aliens and Space: Key Text: Aliens Love Underpants

Making a plasticine alien and writing what he might be saying,
weighing and ordering aliens and our famous pants race are just
some of the fun and exciting activities we will be experiencing!

Dragons: Key Texts - Zog

In our topic about Dragons we will be exploring different fictional dragons. We may even find there are some Dragons on the loose

How to help at home:

Visit your local library and explore books about mythical and magical creatures.

Go on an adventure in the woods and/or other outside environments.

Make different magical creatures out of playdough, plasticine, junk modelling, as well as painting and drawing. Have a go at labelling your creations and even writing a sentence about them.

Wk 5: come


Wk 6: Revisit and Review

<u>Maths</u>


In Maths this half-term we will be learning about number bonds. We will start be exploring different number bonds to 5 (two numbers that add up to make 5). We will be introducing the children to the part-whole diagram to show different number bonds.







We will also be looking at different ways to represent the numbers 6, 7. 8, 9 and 10 and helping the children to recognise how many objects are in a group by arranging them in tens frames.



How to help:

Ensure you child is confident counting objects accurately. Can they make different number bonds to 5? Can they recognise how many objects are in a group by arranging them in a ten frame? Can they recognise all numbers to 10?



PSHE

This half-term we will be continuing to focus on teaching the children to play co-operatively in groups. We will be encouraging the children to take turns and to take account of others ideas.

During the term, we will be encouraging the children to think about the effect of exercise on their bodies as they join in with our PE lessons.

We will also be looking at the importance of hand washing. We will be carrying out several experiments to explore the effects of not washing our hands.
