

This half-term our theme will be Superheroes

Week One and Two: Supertato

This week we will be kicking off our Superhero topic with the Supertato books. I wonder what things Evil Pea will get up to during this week

Week Three and Four: The Naughty Bus

Our theme this week will be Transport Heroes. The children will be role playing some Naughty activities with the toy bus and taking pictures of all the Naughty things their bus gets up to!

Week Five and Six: Fictional Superheroes

This week we will be following the children's interests and learning about the superheroes that the children are interested in.

Week Seven: I am a Superhero!

During this theme the children will be thinking about themselves as superheroes. We will be writing our own superhero stories.

Getting Ready for Year One

Throughout this half-term we will be talking about and preparing the children for their move into Year One.

How to help at home:

Make up a superhero – draw/paint or make a 3D version. Have a go at labelling your picture. Write about their superpowers. Find out about Real Life Superheroes from books or the internet.

Writing

In our English lessons the children will be writing their own sentences independently. We will be writing a range of stories about the different Superheroes we are learning about.

Handwriting

We will be continuing our daily handwriting lessons and practise. We will be revisiting all the letter families, ensuring that the children are forming all the letters correctly. We will be learning how to position the letters on the line and thinking about the correct sizing of the letters.

SUMMER TERM 1 SUPERHEROES



PSHE

This half-term we will be settling the children into the new routines of school, we will continue to learn about the importance of handwashing and practise this regularly throughout the day. We will also be thinking about the transition to Year One and preparing the children through circle time sessions.

We will continue to teach the children to read new red words. See below for the list of red words we will be covering each week

Maths

Subtraction

We will be learning to take-away using objects, using a part-whole model to represent the calculations as well as learning to use number lines to take-away numbers.

Numbers to 20

We will be learning to count forwards and backwards, count objects to 20, recognise all numbers to 20 and order them. We will also be thinking about the how many tens and ones there are in each number.

Doubling, Halving and Sharing

We will be learning to understand the concepts of double, halving and sharing. We will be using objects to double numbers and share quantities fairly.

How to help:

- Practice counting forwards and backwards from different numbers. Count beyond 20
- Count in 2's, 5's and 10's
- Encourage your child to recognise larger numbers when you are out and about.
