Year N - Nursery

This week, we have read 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and 'The Crunching Munching Caterpillar'. The children have had lots of fun with finger painting caterpillars, putting the stories into the correct sequence and collaging a very big caterpillar!

In Maths this week the children have been continuing to learn numbers 1-10 by playing Binao.

In our Letters and Sounds activity the children have enjoyed a game called 'Cross the River'. The children had to listen for the initial sounds of words, if they could correctly say the initial sound they could jump across the river.

This week we have learnt the sounds: 'n' and 'p'. The children will be taking home a few Read, Write, Inc sheets for them to practice writing the sounds.

Year R - Reception

This week has been very exciting for Reception. We had so much fun dressing up as our favourite Superheroes and discussing our different super powers. We made lots of Superhero art work including puppets and midnight scenes for our superheroes to play in. In Maths this week we have been learning to double numbers using numicon. We have also been sorting between doubled and non doubled quantities.

We have been practicing the One Armed Robot Letters in our handwriting lessons and learning the air and ir sounds in RWInc.



Year 1

In Year 1 this week we have finished making some fantastic leaflets about the seasons. The children have explained and described the changes that happen during the different season in the year. We have had lots of fun in Maths this week learning about positional language. We have been doing some practical activities to describe the position of objects and have been guiding each other around by giving instructions for example; forward, backward, quarter turn and half turn. The children have been very creative with making puppets. We have had so many amazing designs! The children have been so excited to take them home and show them off.
