	<p>Introduce the new story to the children and encourage them to talk about the front cover and predict the story.</p> <p>Read the story to the children and encourage them to answer the questions. Teach the children new vocabulary while reading:</p> <p>Peace Tired Uncomfortable</p> <p>Key questions:</p>	<p>Explain the learning and new word capacity.</p> <p>In the story, Mr Bear felt hungry in the night – so he went to the kitchen to have something to eat. If I feel thirsty in the night, I might have a drink.</p> <p>When I take my cup out of the cupboard it is empty. I can describe the capacity of my cup as empty. I want to fill it up. Now it is full.</p>	<p>Explain the learning and new word 'nocturnal'.</p> <p>Let's get out our 'binoculars' out and see if we can spot the nocturnal animals in the picture (from the story).</p> <p>What other animals might you see at night? Can you use the pictures on the slide to help you?</p> <p>I wonder if you have ever seen a nocturnal animal?</p>	<p>Watch Alpha blocks. Can you join in with saying some sounds?</p>

	<p>What can you see on the front cover?</p> <p>Who might be in the story?</p> <p>What do you think might happen?</p> <p>How does Mr Bear feel? Why?</p> <p>What can you see in this picture?</p> <p>Which area do you think he has moved to?</p> <p>Have you ever slept anywhere other than your bedrooms?</p>	<p>Can you say when your cup is full/empty?</p> <p>Maybe you could do some washing up/play with water, and say when the dishes are full/empty with water.</p>

	Re-read the story to the children (watch the video) and encourage the children to make the noises described in the story.	<p>Flash cards from 1-5.</p> <p>Recap yesterday's learning and explain today's learning.</p> <p>Show children different shaped containers. These containers are empty. I want to fill them up. Model this. Repeat a few times.</p>	<p>Explain the learning and include what we use our ears for.</p> <p>Take the children for a walk or stand in the garden or another open space, and listen carefully to the noises they hear.</p>	Watch Alpha blocks. Can you join in with saying some sounds?

	<p>Explain the new learning. Explain the word 'peace'.</p> <p>Give some examples of 'peaceful' places from the story. Explain why it is peaceful.</p> <p>Where might you go in your house to get some peace? Can you think of anywhere?</p> <p>How might you need to behave so it is a peaceful place? Look back at the text to support children's understanding of the new word.</p>	<p>Explain the learning and new vocabulary:</p> <p>First, then, next, finally (show the children these words).</p> <p>Look at some pictures of the story - can the children say where Mr Bear went first, then, next and finally? Can you join in with saying the events with Miss Spelman?</p> <p>You might want to retell the story, and go to the places that Mr Bear went to in <i>your</i> house!</p>	<p>Explain the learning and refer back to the word learned in Literacy (peaceful).</p> <p>Can you make a peaceful place for your teddy to sleep? Where might it be? What might you need to make sure of?</p>	Read a story from Oxford Owl
