Friday 6th February 2.45pm Parents and Carers Invited	Mastery in Number lessons in the classroom 	Come and see Number in Mastery in action in your child's class. This session takes place daily to embed fluency skills in Maths.
Tuesday 10th February	Science Day Einstein's Workshop	The children will have a special Year Group workshop entertained by a Scientist. He will be performing a range of age-appropriate fun science experiments for the children.
Thursday 5th March	World Book Day Dressing up Day	The children can come to school dressed up as their favourite book character.
Friday 6th March 3pm Parents and Carers Invited	Share a book open door	Come into class and share a story book with your child and find out what they have been up to during Book Week.
